



PROTECTION FROM DEADLY DISEASE

When disasters strike, they don't just take away homes and devastate livelihoods. They often leave people vulnerable to deadly diseases like malaria - affecting families and whole communities long after the disaster has passed.

Caused by storms, tsunamis, cyclones and hurricanes, flooding leaves stagnant water behind. This creates a breeding site for mosquitos.

Our mosquito nets help prevent the spread of mosquito-borne diseases such as Zika Virus and malaria in high-risk countries across the world.

Coated with insecticide, the nets offer families an extra layer of protection, and reduce the risk of infection, by killing insects on and around the net.

The nets not only help families sleep better at night, but they are also a symbol of hope for families caught in the chaos of disaster.
